



## **CDC Guidelines for Summer Camp at Fort Bluff Camp**

1. Campers will be required to have their temperature taken 72 hours in advance of the start of camp and the morning of departure.
2. Group leaders and campers will be given the CDC questionnaire to fill out prior to leaving for camp.
3. Fort Bluff summer staff will be given the CDC questionnaire and will be asked to be tested prior to orientation.
4. Fort Bluff staff will take the temperature of each guest upon arrival to camp and again every morning during the week.
5. All staff will have their temperature taken each morning.
6. Any guest or staff that has an elevated temperature will be isolated in a private room near the nurse station.
7. Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the campus.
8. Food Service will wear face coverings while serving meals. Housekeeping will wear face masks while disinfecting and cleaning guest bathrooms.
9. Campers will social distance in the dining hall while in line and tables will only seat four. Fort Bluff staff will serve the food and tea.
10. The campers will be divided into cohorts or pods of approximately 50 for activities and meals.
11. Equipment for activities will be sanitized between cohort use.
12. We will social distance in the chapel for services.
13. Campers will sleep head to toe 6 feet apart in all lodging
